- 20333 1933 (May 3) 1st South America Zeppelin Flight Cover to Brazil via Berlin. F-VF registered cover, neatly opened at bottom. Colorful nine stamp franking, C5-C11 + two additional C11. S.202 €850..... \$500.00

- 12919 1926 (Aug. 11) Haileybury Rouyn VF Flight cover with CL10a signed by the pilot, Glyn R. Burge..... \$225.00

18068 1946 Burned Newspaper Recovered from Air France's Copenhagen to Paris First Flight crash. Newspaper addressed to Paris. All crew members were killed on the flight..... \$250.00

- 20142 1928 (Aug 23) Ile de France Catapult Flight Signed by Pilot Demouget. Six line flight cachet and octagonal cancels on registered cover \$75.00

BALLOON MONTÉS

- 19798 Le "Victor Hugo" F-VF complete folded letter, Oct 18, 1870 Paris cancel, 3 backstamps including Coueron, its destination in French Brittany, carried 440 kg of mail. (BM15 €450)..... \$175.00



- 19828 Le "Kepler" complete folded letter, Jan 10, 1871 Paris cancel, sent to Ryes (Jan 13, 1871) backstamp, carried 160 kg of mail. The aeronauts could hear Prussian artillery aimed at Paris even though they had been airborne in frightful cold for over 5 hours. (BM57 €500) \$230.00

- 21573 US 1934 (May 13) Pond-Sabelli Attempted Non-stop Transatlantic Flight to Rome, Crash in Ireland with C17. 1998 Irish Crash Airmail Catalogue # 34.05.15.1 variety. Unusual with C17, not UC8. Specially sent to London to the Italian Ambassador and not further mailed back to NY. Possibly unique as such to London. Signed by Cesare Sabelli and George Pond, the pilots..... \$600.00
21575 US 1934 Pond-Sabelli Attempted Non-stop Transatlantic Flight to Rome, Crash in Ireland. 1998 Irish Crash Airmail Catalogue # 34.05.15.6 variety. Envelope addressed to Sabelli, c/o American Embassy in Rome. This was previously unknown. The accompanying letter attests to the First Official Air Mail between the U.S. and Ireland (only other known one is damaged) Both letter and envelope are affixed with the Golden City Seal of Dublin and signed by the Lord Mayor of Dublin..... \$3,500.00
